MURPHYSBORO MAN SENTENCED TO PRISON FOR BURGLARY

Michael C. Carr, Jackson County State's Attorney, announced today that a Murphysboro man was sentenced to prison for burglary on March 31, 2015.

Dylan J. Moutria, 25, of Murphysboro, IL, who was charged in Jackson County Circuit Court with Burglary, was sentenced to serve five (5) years in the Illinois Department of Corrections. The defendant will serve a period of Mandatory Supervised Release upon his release from the Department of Corrections of two (2) years.

On November 28, 2014, officers with the Murphysboro Police Department responded to B&B Guns and Ammo, located in Murphysboro, for the report of a burglary. Upon speaking with the owner of that business, officers learned that the suspect gained entry into the business and attempted to gain entry into a number of safes inside the business.

Upon reviewing video surveillance inside the business, officers were able to identify the suspect as the defendant, Dylan Moutria. Officers later located the defendant, and during an interview, the defendant admitted his involvement in the burglary.

This investigation was conducted by the Murphysboro Police Department. Assistant State's Attorney Casey Bloodworth prosecuted this case.
