CARBONDALE MAN SENTENCED FOR ARMED ROBBERY

Michael C. Carr, Jackson County State's Attorney, announced today that Jordan X. Hale, 20, of Carbondale formerly from Woodstock, IL, plead guilty to Armed Robbery stemming from an incident which occurred December 29, 2014 in Carbondale. Investigation revealed that Jordan X. Hale, along with another individual, entered the residence of two sisters living at the Georgetown Apartments on East Grand Street in Carbondale. Entry was made by kicking in the front door. The defendant was armed with a handgun when he entered the apartment. The defendant and his accomplice demanded money from the sisters and ransacked the apartment looking for items. Eventually, the accomplice took several items of property and left the apartment. As Jordan X. Hale exited the apartment, he fired off several warning shots at individuals who were in the area.

Jordan X. Hale has been sentenced to twenty-six (26) years in the Illinois Department of Corrections with credit for 71 days served in the Jackson County Jail. This is a day for day sentence meaning that he will be eligible to get one day off of his sentence for each day he completes in prison without incident. He will be subject to three (3) years Mandatory Supervised Release upon his release from the Department of Corrections.

This case was investigated by the Carbondale Police Department. Assistant State's Attorney Mark Hamrock prosecuted this case.
