### CARBONDALE MAN SENTENCED

Michael C. Carr, Jackson County State's Attorney, announced today that Jorrian A. Sutton, 20, of Carbondale was sentenced to a term of eight years in the Illinois Department of Corrections on a charge of Unlawful Possession of Heroin with the Intent to Deliver.

The evidence showed that on September 23, 2014, Sutton was driving a vehicle while his license was suspended. When he was placed under arrest, he was found to be in possession of 24 individually packaged bags of a substance containing heroin.

This sentence will be served as impact incarceration and the defendant will be subject to two years of Mandatory Supervised Release upon his release from the Department of Corrections.

This case was investigated by the Carbondale Police Department and was prosecuted by Assistant State's Attorney Mark Hamrock.
