A Carbondale resident was charged on February 9, 2015, in an information filed in the Circuit Court of Jackson County with Resisting a Peace Officer and Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, both Class A Misdemeanors, Wrong Way on a One Way Street, a Petty offense, and Operating an Uninsured Motor Vehicle, a Business Offense, the States Attorney for Jackson County, Michael C. Carr, announced today.

Lance Jack, 44, of Carbondale, Illinois, was arrested January 30, 2015, by the Carbondale Police Department. His bond was set at \$3,000, which he posted on the date of his arrest. He is scheduled to appear Thursday, February 19, 2015, at 9:00 p.m. for a first appearance.

A Class A Misdemeanor carries a maximum penalty of up to one year in the Jackson County Jail or two years of probation, with a fine of up to \$2,500. A business offense carries a fine of \$500 to \$1,000 for a first offense, and a petty offense carries a maximum of six months of probation and a \$1,000 fine.

***Under the law, a defendant is presumed to be innocent of a charge until proved guilty beyond a reasonable doubt to the satisfaction of a jury.***

The investigation was conducted by the Carbondale Police Department

State's Attorney Michael C. Carr and Assistant States Attorney Patrick Brewster are prosecuting the case.
