## **CARTERVILLE MAN CONVICTED OF UNAUTHORIZED VIDEO RECORDING**

A Jackson County jury returned a guilty verdict against a Carterville man on Friday, July 17, 2015, for the offense of Unauthorized Video Recording which occurred in Carbondale on last year, States Attorney for Jackson County Michael C. Carr, announced today.

The evidence showed that on June 11, 2014, Michael Todd Norrington, 41, of Carterville, knowingly used his cell phone to take photographs under or through the clothing of a girl 14 years of age, without the consent of the girl or her mother, for the purpose of viewing the body or undergarments worn by girl, while the girl was shopping at a retail store in Carbondale. Due to the age of the victim, the offense is a Class 3 Felony, with a sentencing range of two (2) to five (5) years in the Illinois Department of Corrections. It is a probation eligible offense. A sentencing date is set for September 15, 2015.

This investigation was conducted by the Carbondale Police Department. Assistant State's Attorney Casey Bloodworth was responsible for the prosecution of this case.
