## **TWO MEN SENTENCED FOR RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY**

Michael C. Carr, Jackson County State's Attorney, announced today that two men were sentenced for residential burglary on September 30, 2014, and were sentenced to prison.

Nicholas C. Cuprisin, 21, of Scottsdale, AZ, and Andrew D. McIntyre, 34, of Carbondale, IL, who were charged in Jackson County Circuit Court with Residential Burglary, were sentenced to the Illinois Department of Corrections. Nicholas Cuprisin was sentenced to serve six (6) years in the IDOC, and Andrew McIntyre was sentenced to serve five (5) years in the IDOC. Each defendant will serve a two year period of Mandatory Supervised Release upon release from the Department of Corrections.

On July 27, 2014, the Carbondale Police Department responded to a residence on Lewis Lane. Upon arrival, officers met with the victim who reported unknown suspects entered his residence without permission and took a number of items. Officers determined entry was likely gained through a window of the residence. While on-scene, officers made contact with defendant Cuprisin and questioned him about the burglary. During that conversation, officers conducted a search of defendant Cuprisin's person. Officers discovered some of the victim's property in his pockets. During interviews with defendant Cuprisin, officers learned that defendant McIntyre was also responsible for the burglary. Most of the victim's property was later

recovered from defendant McIntyre's home. Both defendants were interviewed and ultimately admitted their involvement in burglarizing the victim's home.

This investigation was conducted by the Carbondale Police Department. Assistant State's Attorney Casey Bloodworth was responsible for the prosecution of this case.
