CARBONDALE MAN SENTENCED ON DRUG CHARGES

Michael C. Carr, Jackson County State's Attorney, announced today that Pulaski Graham, 51, of Carbondale was sentenced to four (4) years in the Illinois Department of Corrections for Delivery of a Controlled Substance which took place January 17, 2014, in Carbondale.

Mr. Graham, originally from Tennessee, was captured on audio and video recording selling crack cocaine to a confidential source working with the Carbondale Police Department Drug Task Force.

The defendant will serve this sentence as a day-for-day sentence, which means that he will be eligible to get one day off of his sentence for each day he completes in prison without incident, and he will receive credit for 318 days times served on this sentence. Upon his release from the Department of Corrections, he will be subject to a period of two (2) years Mandatory Supervised Release.

This case was investigated by the Carbondale Police Department and was prosecuted by Assistant State's Attorney Mark Hamrock.
