CARBONDALE MAN CONVICTED OF ROBBERY

Michael C. Carr, Jackson County State's Attorney, announced today that Carbondale resident, Quovadis D. Myers, 18, was sentenced to the Department of Corrections after a plea of guilty to the charge of robbery.

On June 5, 2015, the defendant, along with two other individuals, met and planned a robbery of the Citgo Station on South Illinois Avenue in Carbondale. While one individual stood outside as a look-out, the defendant and another entered the business and went behind the counter. The defendant punched the clerk, knocking him to the ground, while the second individual took the cash register drawer and its contents. The other individuals involved entered pleas of guilty earlier this year.

Robbery is a Class 2 Felony. Myers was sentenced to serve three (3) years in the Department of Corrections, followed by two (2) years of Mandatory Supervised Release.

The investigation was conducted by the Carbondale Police Department. Assistant State's Attorney Mark Hamrock was responsible for the prosecution of this case.
