SIMEON PATTERSON, CARBONDALE, SENTENCED FOR DELIVERY OF CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES

Michael C. Carr, Jackson County State's Attorney, announced today that a Carbondale man was sentenced today on two separate cases to terms in the Illinois Department of Corrections.

Simeon Patterson, 21, of Carbondale, Illinois, pleaded guilty to two counts of delivery of crack cocaine to a person working with the Carbondale Police Department Drug Task Force which occurred on October 15 and October 26, 2015. He was sentenced to six (6) years in the Department of Corrections, followed by a two-year period of Mandatory Supervised Release.

Patterson also pled guilty to allegations of a Petition to Revoke Probation stemming from an incident in 2012. In that case, he pled guilty to two counts of Aggravated Battery and was placed on Probation. He violated the terms of his probation by failing to report for scheduled appointments. He was sentenced to three (3) years in the Department of Corrections to run concurrent with his sentence in the drug delivery case.

The investigations were conducted by the Carbondale Police Department. Assistant State's Attorneys Mark Hamrock and Penny Pierson were responsible for the prosecution of the cases.
