### **CARBONDALE MAN SENTENCED TO PRISON FOR RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY**

Michael C. Carr, Jackson County State's Attorney, announced today that a Carbondale man pled guilty to Residential Burglary on February 17, 2015, and was sentenced to prison.

Terrance D. Godfrey, 42, of Carbondale, IL, was convicted in Jackson County Circuit Court of Residential Burglary and was sentenced to serve ten (10) years in the Illinois Department of Corrections. The defendant will serve a three (3) year period of Mandatory Supervised Release upon his release from the Department of Corrections.

On November 27, 2014, officers with the Carbondale Police Department were dispatched to a residential burglary that occurred in the 300 block of East Hester Street. Upon arrival, officers met with the victims, who were not at their residence when the burglary occurred. The victims informed officers that a number of electronic items were stolen from their residence during their absence.

Officers developed the defendant as a suspect, and during their investigation officers and detectives obtained a search warrant for the defendant's home. Upon executing that search warrant, officers recovered some of the victim's property inside the defendant's residence. Upon being interviewed by detectives, the defendant admitted to committing the burglary.

This investigation was conducted by the Carbondale Police Department. Assistant State's Attorney Casey Bloodworth prosecuted this case.
