KYLE WILLS, CARBONDALE, SENTENCED TO ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS FOR POSSESSION OF METHAMPHETAMINE

Michael C. Carr, State's Attorney for Jackson County, Illinois, announced today that Kyle A. Wills, age 29, of Carbondale, Illinois, was sentenced in Jackson County Circuit Court to serve a three-year term in the Illinois Department of Corrections after pleading guilty to the charge of Unlawful Possession of Methamphetamine, a Class 3 Felony.

On April 24, 2017, officers from the Carbondale Police Department were dispatched to Kohl's Department Store regarding a report of a suspicious vehicle possibly involved in a retail theft. The vehicle was located in a nearby business parking lot. Wills, along with two others were near the vehicle. The vehicle was ultimately searched, and a small amount of methamphetamine was located therein. The defendant was identified as the driver of the vehicle, and the other occupants acknowledged that Wills was the person in possession of the methamphetamine.

Wills was sentenced to serve three (3) years in the Illinois Department of Corrections followed by a one (1) year period of Mandatory Supervised Release upon his release from prison.

This matter was investigated by the Carbondale Police Department. Assistant State's Attorney Mark Hamrock was responsible for the prosecution of this case.
