### BRYAN D. WISE, CARBONDALE, FOUND GUILTY OF AGGRAVATED BATTERY WITH A FIREARM

A Jackson County Jury returned verdict of guilty against Bryan D. Wise, II, age 30 of Carbondale, Illinois, for the charge of Aggravated Battery with a Firearm following a two-day jury trial, the State's Attorney for Jackson County, Illinois, Michael C. Carr, announced today.

On July 4, 2017, Carbondale Police were dispatched to Memorial Hospital of Carbondale in reference to a patient with a gunshot wound. After meeting with the victim, officers learned that the shooting occurred outside of a residence on East Willow Street in Carbondale. The victim quickly identified the defendant as the person who shot him. The victim was treated for a gunshot wound to his clavicle and later transferred to a St. Louis hospital for surgery.

Wise is scheduled to be sentenced on April 25, 2018, at 9:30 a.m. He will remain in custody without bond awaiting sentencing. Aggravated Battery with a Firearm is a Class X Felony, with a maximum penalty of six to thirty years in the Illinois Department of Corrections.

This case was investigated by the Carbondale Police Department. Assistant State's Attorney Casey E. A. Bloodworth was responsible for the prosecution of this case.
