BRYAN D. WISE, II, CARBONDALE, SENTENCED TO PRISON FOR AGGRAVATED BATTERY WITH A FIREARM

Michael C. Carr, State's Attorney for Jackson County, Illinois, announced today that Bryan D. Wise, 30, of Carbondale, Illinois, was sentenced to the Illinois Department of Corrections after having been found guilty of Aggravated Battery with a Firearm.

A Jackson County Jury returned verdict of guilty against Bryan D. Wise, II on March 6, 2018, for the charge of Aggravated Battery with a Firearm following a two-day jury trial. The evidence presented at trial established that on July 4, 2017, Carbondale Police were dispatched to Memorial Hospital of Carbondale in reference to a patient with a gunshot wound. After meeting with the victim, officers learned that the shooting occurred outside of a residence on East Willow Street in Carbondale. The victim quickly identified the defendant as the person who shot him. The victim was treated for a gunshot wound to his clavicle and later transferred to a St. Louis hospital for surgery.

A sentencing hearing was held on June 13, 2018, where evidence in aggravation and mitigation was presented to the Court. Following that hearing, the Court sentenced the defendant to twenty-three (23) years in the Department of Corrections. The defendant must serve 85% of this sentence. The defendant will also serve a three (3) year period of Mandatory Supervised Release upon his release from prison.

This case was investigated by the Carbondale Police Department. Assistant State's Attorney Casey E. A. Bloodworth was responsible for the prosecution of this case.
