ADRIAN J. WILLIAMS, ST. LOUIS, SENTENCED FOR UNLAWFUL POSSESSION OF A STOLEN VEHICLE

Michael C. Carr, Jackson County State's Attorney, announced today that Adrian J. Williams, 61, of St. Louis, Missouri, was sentenced to the Illinois Department of Corrections after pleading guilty to the charge of Unlawful Possession of a Stolen Motor Vehicle, a Class 2 Felony, on September 18, 2018. He was sentenced to serve four (4) years in the Illinois Department of Corrections, which will be followed by a two (2) year period of Mandatory Supervised Release.

On August 26, 2018, Carbondale Police Officers received a 9-1-1 report of a vehicle being driven recklessly eastbound on East Walnut Street near Marion Street in Carbondale, Illinois. A registration check of the license plate found the vehicle to have been reported as stolen from Alton, Illinois. The driver was identified as Adrian J. Williams. Officials from the Alton Police Department confirmed that the vehicle was reported stolen on August 13, 2018, and that Williams had not been given permission from the owner to be in possession of the vehicle.

The investigation was conducted by the Carbondale Police Department. Assistant State's Attorney Rebecca L. Blomer was responsible for the prosecution of this case.
