J. D. CARTER, CARBONDALE, SENTENCED TO DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS FOR UNLAWFUL USE OF WEAPONS BY A FELON

Michael C. Carr, Jackson County State's Attorney, announced today, J. D. Carter, Age 64, was sentenced to the Illinois Department of Corrections for the offense of Unlawful Use of Weapons by a Felon.

On January 11, 2018 officers of the Carbondale Police Department received information that the defendant's residence was being utilized as for criminal activity. Officers applied for and were granted a search warrant for the defendant's residence. When the warrant was executed, officers discovered a loaded H&R Model 922 revolver, and a loaded .22 caliber rifle.

On October 25, 2018, Carter pled guilty to the charge of Unlawful Use of a Weapon by a Felon and was sentenced to two (2) years in the Illinois Department of Corrections, followed by a one (1) year period of mandatory supervised release. This is a Class 3 Felony.

The investigation was conducted by the Carbondale Police Department. Assistant State's Attorney Andrew W. Suthard was responsible for the prosecution of this case.
