LOGAN R. HUPPERT, MURPHYSBORO, SENTENCED TO ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS FOR DOMESTIC BATTERY

Michael C. Carr, Jackson County State's Attorney, announced today that Logan R. Huppert, 21, of Murphysboro, Illinois, was sentenced to serve 18 months in the Illinois Department of Corrections for the offense of Domestic Battery.

On October 11, 2017, eyewitnesses reported to police that they observed Huppert strike his girlfriend in the face multiple times. Carbondale police officer located Huppert and the victim shortly thereafter. Huppert pled guilty to the charge of Domestic Battery, a Class 4 Felony due to a prior domestic battery conviction, on September 24, 2018. Upon his release from prison he will serve a four (4) year period of mandatory supervised release.

This case was investigated by the Carbondale Police Department. Assistant State's Attorney Penny J. Pierson was responsible for the prosecution of the case.
