CODY J. TINDLE, MURPHYSBORO, SENTENCED TO DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS FOR UNLAWFUL POSSESSION OF METHAMPHETAMINE

Michael C. Carr, Jackson County State's Attorney, announced today that Cody J. Tindle, age 25, of Murphysboro, Illinois, was sentenced to the Illinois Department of Corrections for the offense of Possession of Methamphetamine on Tuesday, January 29, 2019.

On December 26, 2018, an officer with the Murphysboro Police Department, while on patrol, recognized Tindle and knew him to have an active warrant for his arrest. A search of his person incident to arrest revealed 24 grams of methamphetamine.

On January 29, 2018, Tindle pled guilty to the charge of Possession of 15-100 grams of Methamphetamine, a Class 1 Felony, and was sentenced to five (5) years in the Illinois Department of Corrections, followed by a two (2) year period of mandatory supervised release. Tindle is also currently on probation in Franklin County for Possession of Methamphetamine.

The investigation was conducted by the Murphysboro Police Department. Assistant State's Attorney Andrew W. Suthard was responsible for the prosecution of this case.
