### **JARRELL PULLEN, CARBONDALE, FOUND GUILTY OF FIRST-DEGREE MURDER AND AGGRAVATED DISCHARGE OF A FIREARM**

State's Attorney Michael Carr announced today that Jarrell J. Pullen, 24, of Carbondale, Illinois, was found guilty of two counts of First-Degree Murder and four counts of Aggravated Discharge of a Firearm, following a three-day bench trial in Jackson County.

First Degree Murder carries a potential sentence of 20 to 60 years in prison. However, because the Court found that Pullen personally discharged a firearm that proximately caused the death of the victim, Pullen faces an additional extended term sentence of 25 years to life in prison. Aggravated Discharge of a Firearm is a Class 1 felony that carries a potential sentence of four (4) to fifteen (15) years in prison.

Pullen was remanded to the custody of the Jackson County Sheriff pending sentencing.

This case was investigated by the Carbondale Police Department. State's Attorney Michael C. Carr was responsible for the prosecution.
