BRAD A. GALE, JACOB, ILLINOIS, SENTENCED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS FOR BURGLARY AND METHAMPHETAMINE POSSESSION

Michael C. Carr, Jackson County State's Attorney, announced today that on June 11, 2019, Brad A. Gale, 38, of Jacob, Illinois, was sentenced to three (3) years in the Illinois Department of Corrections after Gale entered admissions to violating the conditions of his probation in cases involving charges of Burglary, a Class 2 Felony and Possession of Methamphetamine, a Class 3 Felony. Gale's term in the Illinois Department of Corrections will be followed by a two (2) year period of Mandatory Supervised Release.

Gale's Methamphetamine Possession charge arose out of an October 7, 2018, incident during which he was found in possession of less than five (5) grams of a substance containing methamphetamine. Gale's Burglary charge arose out of a January 4, 2019, incident during which he broke into a motor vehicle on Edith Street in Murphysboro and was later found in possession of property stolen from that vehicle. Gale was placed on probation for these offenses in early 2019. His probation was revoked, and Gale was sentenced to the Illinois Department of Corrections due to his failure to comply with several conditions of the probation orders entered in those cases.

The investigations were conducted by the Murphysboro Police Department. Assistant State's Attorneys Jayson Clark and Andrew Suthard were responsible for the successful prosecution of Gale.
