BRANDON M. LEEK, ANNA, SENTENCED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS FOR POSSESSION OF A STOLEN VEHICLE

Michael C. Carr, Jackson County State's Attorney, announced today that on July 15, 2019, Brandon M. Leek, 28, of Anna, Illinois entered a plea of guilty to the charge of Unlawful Possession of a Stolen Motor Vehicle, a Class 2 Felony. Leek was sentenced to four and one-half (4½) years in the Illinois Department of Corrections followed by a two (2) year period of Mandatory Supervised Release.

On December 28, 2018, the Carbondale Police Department responded to a reported vehicle theft in the parking lot area of a shopping center in Carbondale, Illinois. Leek was seen by a witness stealing a 2003 Buick Regal and driving away. Carbondale police later obtained video surveillance of Leek committing the offense.

The investigation of Leek's case was conducted by the Carbondale Police Department. Assistant State's Attorney Jayson Clark was responsible for the successful prosecution of Leek.
