JIMMIE L. STINSON, CARBONDALE, SENTENCED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS FOR ROBBERY

Michael C. Carr, Jackson County State's Attorney, announced today that Jimmie Stinson, age 55, of Carbondale, Illinois, was sentenced in Jackson County Court today to the Illinois Department of Corrections after pleading guilty to the offense of Robbery.

In the early morning hours of February 1, 2019, Stinson together with Alphonzo E. Higgins, age 49, also of Carbondale, followed two individuals on foot from an ATM on Main Street in Carbondale to the 300 block of South Marion Street. Stinson and Higgins then physically attacked the two individuals, forcing the two individuals to surrender their property.

Stinson pled guilty to the charge of Robbery as a Class 2 Felony on May 21, 2019. Following a pre-sentence investigation, he was sentenced today to serve five (5) years in the Illinois Department of Corrections, followed by a two (2) year period of Mandatory Supervised Release.

In May of 2019, a Jackson County Jury found Higgins guilty of Robbery. He is currently in custody at the Jackson County Jail without bond awaiting sentencing, which is scheduled for August 22, 2019.

The investigation was conducted by the Carbondale Police Department. Assistant State's Attorney Rebecca L. Blomer was responsible for the prosecution of this case.
