CENTRAIL K. GREEN, CARBONDALE, SENTENCED TO DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS FOR UNLAWFUL USE OF A WEAPON BY A FELON

Michael C. Carr, Jackson County State's Attorney, announced today, Centrail K. Green, age 27, of Carbondale, Illinois, was sentenced to the Illinois Department of Corrections for the offense of Unlawful Use of a Weapon by a Felon.

On September 4, 2019, Carbondale police officers were dispatched to the 700 block of Lewis Lane in response to a domestic disturbance. After speaking with witnesses, officers were directed to a vacant apartment nearby where witnesses had observed Green carrying a firearm. A semi-automatic pistol was located within the apartment. Green, a convicted felon, cannot lawfully possess a firearm.

On December 3, 2019, Green pled guilty to the charge of Unlawful Use of a Weapon by a Felon and was sentenced to serve two (2) years in the Illinois Department of Corrections, followed by a one (1) year period of mandatory supervised release. This is a Class 3 Felony.

The investigation was conducted by the Carbondale Police Department. Assistant State's Attorney Andrew W. Suthard was responsible for the prosecution of this case.
