KEVIN J. DAVENPORT, MARION, SENTENCED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS FOR VEHICULAR BURGLARY

Michael C. Carr, Jackson County State's Attorney, announced today that on December 20, 2019, Kevin J. Davenport, 48, of Marion, Illinois, entered a plea of guilty to Vehicular Burglary, a Class 3 Felony offense. Davenport was sentenced to three (3) years in the Illinois Department of Corrections followed by a one (1) year period of Mandatory Supervised Release.

On September 17, 2019, officers of the Carbondale Police Department were called to a Carbondale residence in regard to a possible vehicular burglary in progress. Officers arrived and saw Davenport inside the victim's vehicle. After officers arrested Davenport, he told them that he did not know who the car he was in belonged to and that he was looking for the keys so that he could drive off in the vehicle.

The investigation of Davenport's case was conducted by the Carbondale Police Department. Assistant State's Attorney Jayson Clark was responsible for the successful prosecution of Davenport.
