**ANTHONY P. BODEKER, MURPHYSBORO, SENTENCED
TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS
FOR FORGERY**

Michael C. Carr, Jackson County State's Attorney, announced today that Anthony P. Bodeker, 22, of Murphysboro, Illinois, pled guilty to the charge of Forgery on January 14, 2020, and was sentenced to serve three (3) years in the Illinois Department of Corrections, which will be followed by a one (1) year period of Mandatory Supervised Release.

On July 24, 2019, Anthony P. Bodeker cashed a check at a bank in Murphysboro. The check was later learned to be fraudulent as the account holder had not authorized the writing of the check.

The investigation was conducted by the Murphysboro Police Department. Assistant State's Attorney Jayson Clark was responsible for the prosecution of this case.
