ANDREAKO D. LILLY, CARBONDALE, SENTENCED TO DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS FOR UNLAWFUL POSSESSION OF WEAPONS BY A FELON

Michael C. Carr, Jackson County State's Attorney, announced today, Andreako D. Lilly, age 30, of Carbondale, Illinois, was sentenced to the Illinois Department of Corrections for the offense of Unlawful Possession of Weapons by a Felon.

On November 12, 2019, a 911 call was received with a complaint of a man waving a gun in threatening manner near the 800 building at 700 South Lewis Lane in Carbondale. Officers responded and located the vehicle described by the caller. On approach to the vehicle, officers observed the occupants making quick movements. The occupants were patted down for officer safety. Andreako Lilly was found to possess a .22 caliber revolver. Lilly has a prior felony conviction for possession of a controlled substance and is prohibited from possessing firearms.

On January 15, 2020, Lilly pled guilty to the charge of Unlawful Possession of a Weapon by a Felon, a Class 3 Felony. He was sentenced to twenty-four (24) months in the Illinois Department of Corrections, followed by a one (1) year period of mandatory supervised release.

The investigation was conducted by the Carbondale Police Department. Assistant State's Attorney Andrew W. Suthard was responsible for the prosecution of this case.
