CHARLES M. MINOR, CARBONDALE, SENTENCED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS FOR CRIMINAL SEXUAL ASSAULT

Michael C. Carr, Jackson County State's Attorney, announced today that Charles M. Minor, age 30, was sentenced to the Illinois Department of Corrections for Criminal Sexual Assault.

On May 14, 2019, Carbondale Police responded to Memorial Hospital of Carbondale regarding a complaint of suspected criminal sexual assault to an unresponsive victim. The investigation led to the arrest of Charles M. Minor. Minor was charged with committing an act of sexual penetration upon an individual who was unable to understand the nature of the act.

On January 13, 2020, Minor entered a plea of guilty to Criminal Sexual Assault, a Class 1 Felony. He was sentenced today to serve six years in the Illinois Department of Corrections, followed by a three-year to natural life period of Mandatory Supervised Release. Upon his release from prison, he will be required to register as a sex offender.

The investigation was conducted by the Carbondale Police Department. Assistant State's Attorney Rebecca L. Blomer was responsible for the prosecution of this case.
