RUSSELL D. CONDER, MURPHYSBORO, SENTENCED TO ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS FOR DOMESTIC BATTERY

Michael C. Carr, Jackson County State's Attorney, announced today that Russell Dean Conder, 39, of Murphysboro, Illinois, was sentenced to the Illinois Department of Corrections for the offense of Aggravated Domestic Battery, a Class 2 Felony.

The Aggravated Domestic Battery occurred on October 8, 2019, during a physical altercation between Conder and his girlfriend. The girlfriend's teenage son tried to intervene, and Conder stabbed the teenager several times.

On August 21, 2020, Conder pled guilty but mentally ill to this offense and was sentenced on the same day to serve to four (4) years in the Illinois Department of Corrections, followed by four (4) years of mandatory supervised release .

This case was investigated by the Murphysboro Police Department. Assistant State's Attorney Penny J. Pierson was responsible for the prosecution of the case.
